ADDENDUM C

The following is an amendment to the Area 17 Memorandum of Understanding for Local Workforce Area 17 (MOU) for the extended agreement period ending June 30, 2025.

For Mahoning County, Equus Workforce Solutions has replaced Serrato Group as the Cleveland Job Corp Operator. They have agreed to continue a partnership with our Mahoning County OMJ center as an equal access partner. This does reduce the original agreement from Serrato holding a 1 FTE, to Equus Workforce Solutions becoming an equal access partner.

- A. Appropriate changes have been made to the cost share budget to show MCTA will cover the difference in cost from a .2 FTE and the equal access amount now being covered by Equus Workforce Solutions. No additional cost will be on any MOU partners.
- B. The effective date of this change is January 1, 2024.
